- (a) For posts with **Matriculation as EQ**, the examination will have 150 Questions carrying one mark each, on the four components given below:-

General Intelligence & Reasoning	:	25 Questions
Numerical Aptitude	:	25 Questions
General English	:	50 Questions
General Awareness	:	50 Questions

- (b) For posts with **Higher Secondary as the EQ**, Examination will have 200 Questions carrying one mark each as indicated below:-

General Intelligence & Reasoning	:	50 Questions
Numerical Aptitude	:	50 Questions
General English	:	50 Questions
General Awareness	:	50 Questions

- (c) For posts with **Graduation in any subject & Graduate/Post Graduate Degree** (with specialization in any subject) as the EQ, the Examination will have 200 questions, each carrying one mark, on the following subjects:-

General Intelligence & Reasoning	:	50 Questions
Numerical Awareness	:	50 Questions
Quantitative Aptitude	:	50 Questions
English Comprehension	:	50 Questions

There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.

There will be Computer Based Mode of Examinations consisting of Objective/Multiple Choice Questions, separately for posts with minimum Educational Qualification of Matriculation, Higher Secondary and Graduation and above levels.
